# **AMERICAN FFA DEGREE**

No significant changes are planned to the American FFA Degree application for the 2022-23 year.

Detailed State approval and national submission deadlines are as follows:

- March 15 Applications submitted by this date are guaranteed a two week revision opportunity if required.
- April 15 Applications submitted by this date should have a two week revision opportunity if required, not guaranteed.
- May 15 Applications submitted by this day may have a one week or less revision opportunity, not guaranteed.
- June 15 Final Submission Deadline Applications submitted in June will have no revision opportunity and will be rejected should national review find an issue of any kind.
