AMERICAN FFA DEGREE

No significant changes are planned to the American FFA Degree application for the 2022-23 year.

Detailed State approval and national submission deadlines are as follows:

- **March 15** – Applications submitted by this date are guaranteed a two week revision opportunity if required.
- **April 15** – Applications submitted by this date should have a two week revision opportunity if required, not guaranteed.
- **May 15** – Applications submitted by this day may have a one week or less revision opportunity, not guaranteed.
- **June 15** – Final Submission Deadline – Applications submitted in June will have no revision opportunity and will be rejected should national review find an issue of any kind.
