A team will consist of up to six members with the top three scores being counted. <u>No school may win more than one plaque</u>. All teams registered will be eligible for a plaque.

After the test is completed middle school students will travel to 5-6 different workshops all based upon leadership and agriculture. Possible workshop presentations include: State Officers, District Officers, Chapter Officers, Farm Bureau, Cloud County Aggie Truck, and KSU Ag Ed TASK Force.
