

2023-24 AGRICULTURAL PROFICIENCY AWARD APPLICATION UPDATES

Purpose of Updates

The award application updates are intended to:

- A. Include measurement of all five "SAE for All" Foundational SAE components.
- B. Make the application questions more specific.

Not making the application longer was a constant consideration.

Section Updates

Basic Set Up Section

Current - Applicants are asked to select the AFNR Primary Pathway in which their project and the skills and abilities they have developed through it best fit. All award areas may select from any of the eight AFNR Pathways or Career Ready Practices or Cluster Skills.

Revision – The Biotechnology Systems pathway performance indicators will be available in addition to the performance indicators for the AFNR Pathway selected.

Cluster Skills and the Career Ready Practices will be available only if the award area selected is Agricultural Education or Agricultural Communications.

As AFNR pathway updates are received from the National Council for Agricultural Education the application will be updated in the immediately following award application cycle.

Performance Review A

Revised Section: Applicants will select:

- A. Select up to 5 primary pathway standards/performance indicators you have gained skills, competencies, or knowledge in through your SAE project.
- B. Pathway Select up to 2 pathway standards/performance indicators from any pathway you have gained skills, competencies, or knowledge in through your SAE project.
- C. Select up to 3 Career Ready Practice and/or Cluster Skill content standards you have gained skills, competencies, or knowledge in through your SAE project.

Column Headings are:

Column 1 A: AFNR Performance Indicator from Primary Pathway. Column 2 A: Specifically describe the SAE activities performed to learn or demonstrate the performance indicator selected.

Column 1 B: AFNR Performance Indicator from any Pathway, Column 2 C: Specifically describe the SAE activities performed to learn or demonstrate the performance indicator selected.

Column 1 C: Cluster Skill or Career Ready Practice Performance Indicator Column 2 C: Specifically describe the SAE activities performed to learn or demonstrate the performance indicator selected.

Photos Section

Current Section: Six pages are provided. Each allows the insertion of a single photo and written a caption.

Revised Section: Section will be broken into two separate sections:

- First section will be "Workplace Safety Photos"
 - Two photo pages will be available to insert one photo and caption on each page using the current format. These photos and captions must show and describe the applicant demonstrating a safety practice appropriate for the project described in the application.
- Second section will be "Project Photos"
 - Four pages will be available to insert one photo and caption on each page using the current format. These photos and captions are for the application to show and explain their SAE project as in the current application version.
 - Scoring rubric updated to include deductions for photos or captions which show/discuss unsafe practices.

Supplemental Information Section – No change for the 2023-24 cycle.
