### WYANDOTTE CO. FARM BUREAU SCHOLARSHIP

#### \$500 Scholarship, 1 Year Non-Renewable

The Wyandotte County Farm Bureau Association's scholarship is available for high school seniors graduating in May and whose parents or grandparents are members of Kansas Farm Bureau. As part of the largest agricultural organization in the nation, Wyandotte County Farm Bureau believes it is important to recognize scholastic achievement as well as community and extra-curricular activities of today's youth.

### LEON LALLIER MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP

#### \$500 Scholarship, 1 Year Non-Renewable

Wyandotte County Farm Bureau offer students the Leon Lallier Memorial Scholarship. The scholarship was created in memory Leon Lallier. Leon was well known in the area for his civic and educational interests and his special love of agriculture and the land. He had degrees in history and law but chose to farm and serve his community.

**ATTENTION APPLICANTS:** It is only necessary to fill out one application; you will be automatically considered for both scholarships.

### ELIGIBILITY

- Family must be a member of Farm Bureau (parents or grandparents).
- Student must attend a university, junior college, or trade school in the State of Kansas.
- Preference given to a student pursuing a course of study related to agriculture or who has an agricultural interest or background, but not mandatory.

### SELECTION PROCESS

The committee prefers someone with a farm/agriculture related background, but this is not mandatory. The recipient will also be judged based on academic performance.

### Submit the following:

- The completed application.
- Copy of your high school transcript that contains ACT/SAT test scores and final class ranking.
- Your senior picture, wallet size (photocopy is acceptable).

**Deadline:** Applications must be received in our office by 5:00 PM on April 1. Selection will be made by the middle of April.
